

Rev. James Rommel Hooper, Sr.

Rev. James Rommel Hooper, Sr. serves as the presiding elder of the Pine Bluff-Helena District, in the East Arkansas Conference. He is the senior presiding elder in the Twelfth Episcopal District of the African Methodist Episcopal Church and President Pro tem of the Presiding Elder's Council. Rev. Hooper also serves as the pastor of Greater Ward Chapel African Methodist Episcopal Church located in Pine Bluff, Arkansas.

Rev. Hooper accepted his call to the Christian ministry in March 1969 and was admitted to the South Arkansas Conference where he was ordained an Itinerant Elder by Bishop D. Ward Nichols. His pastoral ministry includes several churches in the South Arkansas Conference, Arkansas Conference, Ohio Conference: Third Episcopal District. In almost every church Rev. Hooper served, he made extensive renovations on the physical structure. He served as presiding elder in the Crossett District and Monticello-Warren District of the East Arkansas Conference, and the Camden-El Dorado District of the West Arkansas Conference.

Rev. Hooper earned his undergraduate degree from Arkansas Agricultural, Mechanical and Normal College (Arkansas AM&N), now known as the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff. He holds a Master of Divinity degree from Payne Theological Seminary, located in Wilberforce, Ohio, and he did additional studies at United Theological Seminary in Dayton, Ohio. Rev. Hooper served as Dean of Jackson Theological Seminary in North Little Rock, Arkansas.

Rev. Hooper owns a collision repair facility where his son, Thomas, manages the body shop. He is married to a wonderful lady Jeanette, who is a valuable asset to his ministry.
