



## HIGHER EDUCATION OPPORTUNITY ACT (HEOA) DISCLOSURES:

### 2017 Graduation Rates by Race/Ethnicity, Gender and Pell/Stafford Loan Recipients

The cohort includes all first-time full-time degree-seeking undergraduate students (Cohort), less qualifying\* exclusions, who enrolled at the University in the fall 2011 semester and completed their degree program within 4-to-6 years. The six-year graduation data are shown in the below Tables 1 through 8. Note: student cohort counts of one or two students are not shown (\*) pursuant to Student Right to Know Act so that no one individual can be identified.
