Overview

The Department of Social and Behavioral Sciences and the School of Education cooperate in administering the Social Studies Education program at UAPB. This program prepares students to receive certification in social studies classroom teaching in Arkansas schools. However, transfer of teaching credentials to most other state certification programs is relatively simple, usually only requiring completion of a state history course which can bet taken during your first year of teaching in the state.

Objectives

The dual objectives of the Department of Social and Behavioral Sciences and the School of Education are to provide our students with the academic knowledge necessary and the teaching skills required to be a successful classroom teacher. Additionally, our program also provides our students with the academic base to continue their education at the graduate level. Such graduate studies, at UAPB or elsewhere, prepare students to become master teachers, or administrators at the school or district level.



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
