UAPB/AM&N Homecoming Parade Policy and Guidelines for Participants

POLICY

- The UAPB Homecoming Parade is one of a series of annual events where the University joins all its constituencies in acknowledgement and celebration of its mission and service to mankind.
- Campaign materials may not be displayed on the elected official's vehicle. Only incumbent national, state, county and city elected officials participate in the parade. Identification of elected officials shall be limited to name and office held.
- For safety reasons, no one will be allowed to ride on the hood of a car or truck. Also, throwing treats or any objects to spectators along the parade route is forbidden.

PARADE GUIDELINES/DIRECTIONS

- All dignitaries should line-up on 15th. EAST of Main Street (between Main and State streets) Participant line-up will commence at 8:00 a.m.
- **BANDS:** UAPB's BAND will go to MAIN St. and Line-up facing NORTH WITH THE LINE FILLING TO THE SOUTH. All Other High School Bands are to UNLOAD on 15th & Olive/Walnut, then WALK IN SINGLE FILE EAST on 15th and proceed to Main St. AND WAIT FOR INSTRUCTIONS. Once BUS is unloaded the bus should make a right/left onto 15th heading west and a Left onto Linden St. then a Left onto Harding Ave. Proceed EAST on Harding St. and make a Left onto STATE St. (next street after Main St) proceed North on STATE St. and make a Right onto 11th then Left on to Convention Center Dr. and PARK IN THE PARKING LOT ON THE LEFT. This is the pick-up location for the end of the parade. Parking is available between 8th and 11th; this will be the location for the end of the parade and pick-up.
- **FIRST ALL PARTICIPANTS PLEASE GO TO LAKESIDE METHODIST CHURCH PARKING LOT ON 15th AND OLIVE/WALNUT St. UNDER THE UAPB BLACK /GOLD TENT FOR FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS AND PARADE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER (NOT ORDER NUMBER) AT 8:00 A.M. SATURDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2024. PLEASE FEEL FREE TO WALK TO PARADE IDENTIFICATION NUMBER STATION. ONLY PARADE ENTRIES ARE ALLOWED IN THE PARKING LOT – ALL OTHER VEHICLES MUST PARK ON THE FAR WEST SIDE OF THE OFF LINDEN ST. PARADE LINE-UP WILL COMMENCE AT 8:15 A.M. LATE ARRIVALS WILL BE PLACED AT THE END OF THE PARADE OR EXCLUDED FROM THE PARADE.**
 - ***Place your parade identification number in the lower right (Passenger side) of the front windshield.*** The official title entry listed on the form may be used only in the parade no exceptions Floats and 18- Wheelers in the parade should proceed to 15th FACING MAIN ST.
 - ***Individuals dropping parade participants off and leaving should have prior knowledge of the location of their respective float, car and should know the registered name of their organization.*** The drivers should drop-off at LINDEN St and 15th St or Park and walk their child to their respective float/car. ALL FLOATS, CARS, TRUCKS AND OTHER MOTORED VEHICLES PARTICIPATING IN THE PARADE SHOULD PROCEED TO 15th St. IF YOU ARE PARTICIPATING IN THE PARADE LINE-UP, YOU SHOULD BE HEADED EAST ON 15TH. TOWARD MAIN ST.

ATTENTION: PARADE ROUTE FOR 2024

PARADE STARTS AT 15th /MAIN STREET. (Participants will line-up on 15th facing Main St.) Turn LEFT on MAIN STREET and travel NORTH TO SIXTH AVENUE. <> Turn RIGHT on SIXTH AVENUE. <> T U R N R I G H T O N C O N V E N T I O N C E N T E R D R. PARADE ENDS AT 9TH /11 and Convention Center Drive.

UNITS TRAVELING BACK TO UAPB's CAMPUS. GET onto 11th St. traveling EAST. MAKE A LEFT ONTO TENNESSEE ST then TURN LEFT onto MISSOURI STREET then LEFT ONTO FIFTH St. (heading West) and MAKE RIGHT ONTO Convention Center Dr. (at the traffic light) travel to MARTHA MITCHELL EXPRESSWAY OR PULLEN ST. Turn LEFT onto MARTHA MITCHELL EXPRESSWAY or PULLEN ST. and travel to UNIVERSITY DRIVE. TURN RIGHT on UNIVERSITY DRIVE to UAPB's campus.
