# **Act 943: Unplanned Pregnancy Prevention**

**Act 943**, passed by the Arkansas Legislature in 2015 directs college and universities to develop and implement action plans to address the prevention of unplanned pregnancy.

Student Health Services suppose these efforts to prevent the unnecessary emotional and financial stress of an unplanned pregnancy therefore, improving the retention and graduation rates of our students.
