- 2. At the dashboard window, select the View Other Terms link under the Terms section on the right of the page.
- 3. Change the Current Term View to a previous term under the dropdown menu.

- 4. Click the green **View Selected Term** button.
- 5. Select the appropriate **Course and Section** from among your courses under the course selection heading (right side of the dashboard) where the old assignment you wish to copy resided.
- 6. Select the **Assignments** tab.
- 7. Check the box next to the assignment you wish to copy from the old course to your new course. You may check multiple boxes if you want to move multiple assignments.
- 8. Click the **Copy** button.
- 9. You should see a list of all the courses and sections you are teaching during the current term.
- 10. Check the box next to the course to which you wish to copy the old assignment. You can copy the old assignment to multiple courses at the same time by checking more than one box.
- 11. Click the **Copy to Courses** button.
