



Student Registration

1. Log on to your UAPB email account
2. Find the email from support@watermarkinsights.com with the subject line “University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff requests that you complete your LiveText registration.”
3. Open the email from support@watermarkinsights.com
4. Click the link following the phrase, “Please complete your LiveText registration here...” or copy the link and paste it into your browser.
5. At the “Choose Your Role” section, be sure the radio button next to “Student” is selected.

6. The Key Code is already in the “Enter Your Key Code” box (notice the black dots in the box).
7. Your first and last names, birthdate, and UAPB email should already be entered.
8. Enter a personal email or re-type your UAPB email.
9. Confirm your second email
10. Country, state, institution, and student ID should already be entered
11. Select the month and year of your Anticipated Graduation Date.
12. Enter a username for your LiveText account (Must contain at least 4 characters, case insensitive).

15. Choose a security question from the dropdown menu
16. Answer the security question
17. Provide a hint to your answer to the security question
18. Check the box next to the confirmation of “Terms of Service”
19. Select “Register My Membership Account”
20. You should see the “Congratulations!” screen. Be sure to write down your username and password and hide them in a secure location.
