## Federal Student Aid Programs

- Do not make any additional income/ household size/ number in college corrections to the FAFSA once this form has been submitted.

**2023 FEDERAL INCOME TAX INFORMATION REQUIREMENT** - As part of federal student aid eligibility, students, and spouses (if applicable), and parents of dependent students, will be **required** to consent and approve sharing and importing income and tax information from the IRS (DDX) to the FAFSA form, even if the attempt to obtain or use such data is ineffective. In other words, if the student and spouse (if married) or parents (of a dependent student) filed separate 2023 IRS income tax returns, all parties must provide consent and approval to share and import income and tax information from the IRS. If a return was not filed, consent and approval remains a requirement.
