### Campus Services & Safety

- **Facilities:** Residence halls remain open. While walkways near housing and dining facilities have been treated with deicer, please exercise extreme caution when traveling across campus.
- **Trash Pickup:** Due to hazardous road conditions, trash pickup is currently delayed. Please ensure all waste is placed **securely inside** the dumpsters to prevent attracting wildlife.
