SECIAL ANNOUNCEMENT: **Transition to Virtual Operations on Monday, Jan. 26, 2026**

We thank our students, faculty, staff, and the entire UAPB community for their patience, flexibility, and cooperation as we work together to prioritize safety during inclement weather conditions.

Due to the current winter weather advisory and hazardous road conditions, the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff will shift to virtual delivery for academic and business operations on Monday, January 26, 2026.

Academic & Business Operations

- **Instruction:** Faculty and students will conduct Monday classes via virtual modalities. Please contact your professors for further information regarding coursework.
- **Operations:** Campus business operations will be handled remotely. Employees should coordinate with their supervisors regarding specific responsibilities.
- **Critical Personnel:** Employees designated as critical personnel, including Campus Police, Technical Services, Facilities Management, and Dining Services, should contact their supervisors for additional information.

Campus Services & Safety

- **Student Residents:** Residence halls remain open. Deicer has been applied to walkways near housing and dining facilities; however, please exercise extreme caution when moving about campus.
- **Dining Services:** Dining hours have been modified for the safety of students and staff. Please visit uapb.campusdish.com for the most current schedule.

Travel & Attendance
