

Student Health Services

Student Health Services provides nursing assessment, first-aid care, health education, wellness services, and referrals for currently enrolled students.

All enrolled students with a valid UAPB identification card are eligible to use Student Health Services.

Available Services

Nursing Assessment and First Aid

- Assessment of minor illnesses and injuries
- Nursing evaluation and symptom assessment
- First-aid care
- Vital sign assessment
- Wound care and dressing changes
- Staple and suture removal (when appropriate)

Health Screening Services

- Blood pressure screening
- Blood sugar screening
- Hemoglobin screening
- CLIA-waived laboratory screening services (when available)

Health Education and Wellness

- Individual health education
- Wellness counseling
- Health promotion activities
- Disease prevention education
- Educational programs and outreach activities

Care Coordination and Referrals

- Assistance with navigating the healthcare system
- Referrals to community healthcare providers
- Referrals to urgent Care centers
- Referrals to specialists
- Referrals to counseling and mental health services
- Referrals to community agencies and healthcare resources

- Crutch loans (when available)
- Braces and supportive devices (when available)
